# Post-Event Report

The World Hospital Congress is an annual forum that brings together leaders and decisionmakers of hospitals, health services, and healthcare organizations for multidisciplinary exchange of knowledge, expertise and experiences and dialogue on best practices in leadership, management and service delivery.

It is a one-stop shop for the healthcare executives and professional seeking the opportunity to engage in a 360-degree learning and knowledge-sharing experience among peers.



#### People on board: Transforming healthcare by blending agility, responsiveness, and resilience

The 44th World Hospital Congress, the first hybrid Congress of the IHF, was co-hosted by La Unió Catalana d'Hospitals (Catalan Hospital, Health and Social Services Association) on 9-11 November 2021 in Barcelona with the overarching theme "People on board: Transforming healthcare by blending agility, responsiveness, and resilience". It was a success with around 1500 participants from 74 countries joining the discussions. More than 300 speakers shared their insights, expertise, and experiences across 70+ sessions and panel discussions. There were also more than 200 posters featured that showcased good practices and innovations from around the world. In addition, 50 outstanding projects and programmes were recognized during the IHF Awards ceremony. In-person attendees enjoyed opportunities to interact again face-to-face with peers during the breaks and social events such as the Welcome Reception, After Work Social Dinner at Museu Nacional d'Art de Catalunya, and Solidarity Concert at Palau de la Música Catalana. There were also hospital visits to Hospital Universitari Vall d'Hebron, Hospital de la Santa Creu i Sant Pau, Hospital Clínic de Barcelona, and Hospital Sant Joan de Déu.

#### Hospital Leaders Look to Build Resilience at the 44th World Hospital Congress

The 44" World Hospital Congress (WHC) came to an upbeat close last week in Barcelona (Spain), a year later than originally planned due to the Covid-19 pandemic. During the event public health leaders and hospital CEOs in Europe and North America exchanged ideas on how organisations can prepare for the next global pandemic, alongside building more resilient healthcare systems.

For the first time, the event was fully hybrid, facilitating the participation of more than 1,200 inperson and 300 online delegates from over 70 countries. For four days, leaders and decision-makers in the healthcare community shared knowledge and good practices, exchanged new ideas and innovations, and networked with other senior executives.


